What is Eligible?

- Cropland that meets cropping history requirements
- Irrigation corners
- 10-40 acre blocks of cropland
- <10 acre fields if adjacent to existing habitat
- Expired CRP
- Food plots are an eligible practice (2 acre maximum)

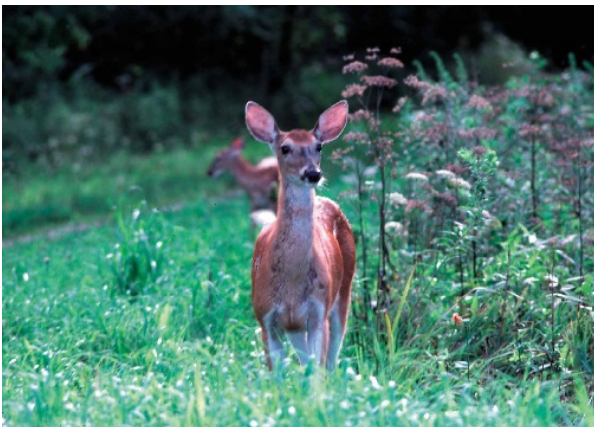

- Stearns County Annual Rental Payments
\$73 - \$106 per acre
- Signing Bonus \$100 per acre
- 50% Cost share plus a 40% practice incentive payment
